Step - 9: College Begins

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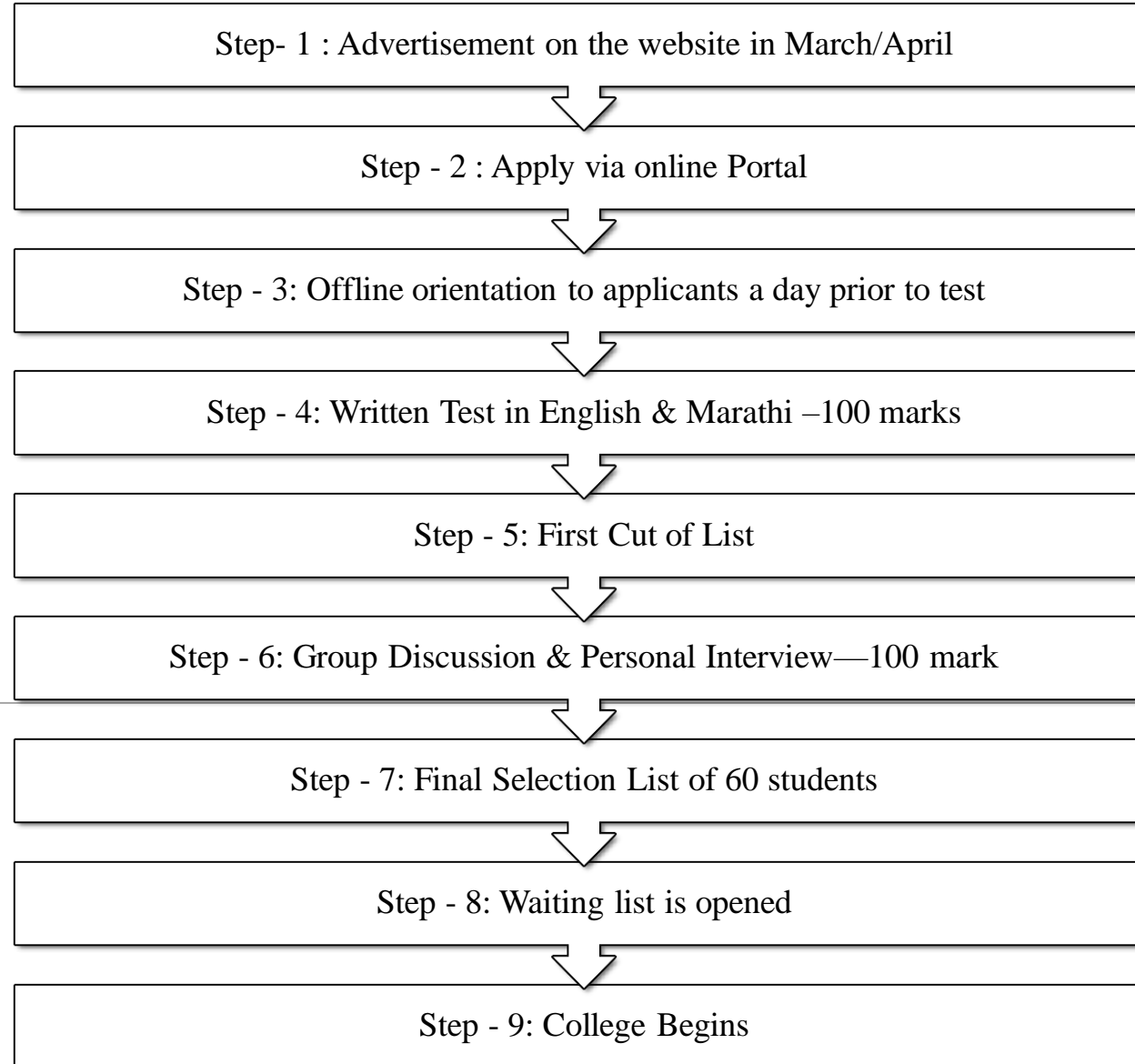


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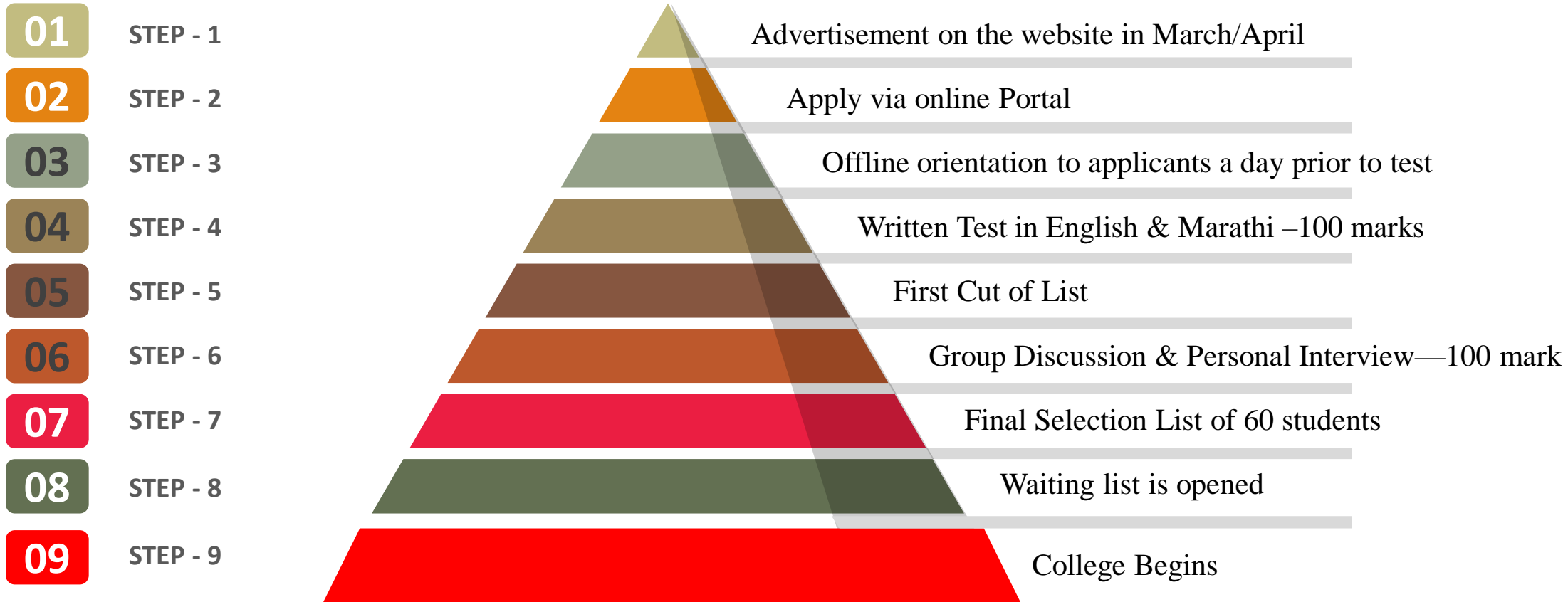


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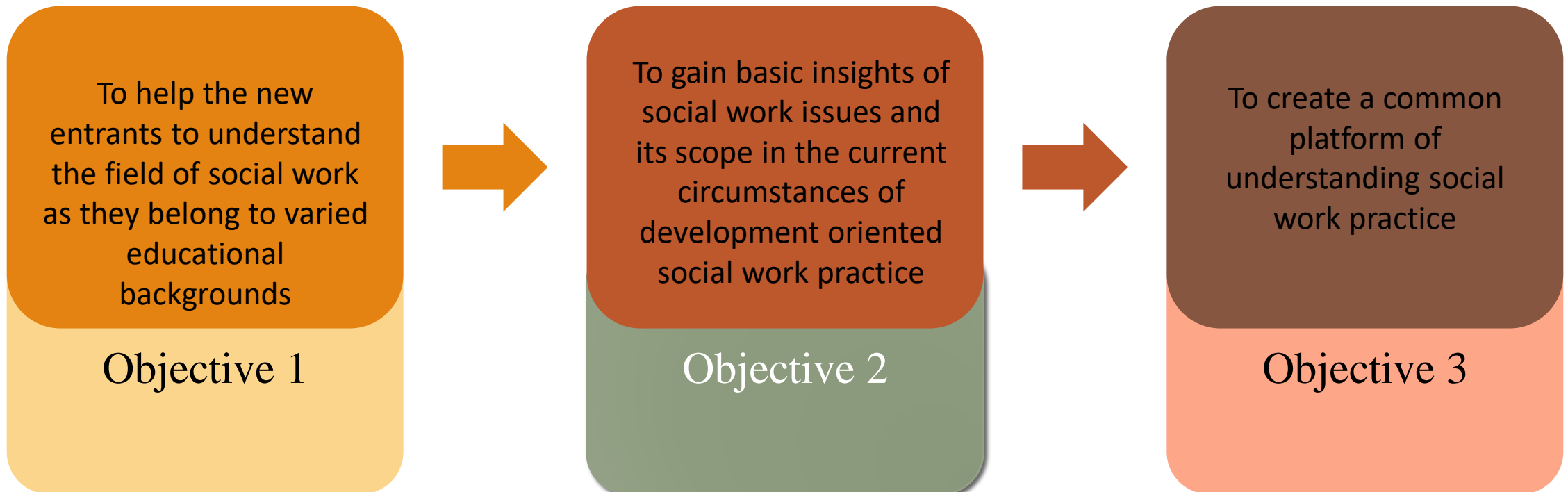
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# Bridge Course:

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When the college begins in 1<sup>st</sup> week of July, a bridge course is compulsory for all the newly admitted students .This course is a combination of theory classes and practical exposure to field of social work.



# This course is a six day program followed by Directors Address

**Bridge Course No-1**

**Every day from 9.00am to 4.00pm**

**= 6 hours 6 days X 6 hours/day**

**= 36 hours**

1. **Day 1& 2 Module-1 : Basic Human Needs**
2. **Day 3&4 Module-2 : Approaches for resolution of Human Problems**
3. **Day 5 & 6 Module-3 : Professional Social Work Education and Training**

**Bridge Course No-2**

**Practical Field Visits to Social Work Organizations**

**The 60 students are divided into 3 groups of 20 each with 2 faculty members in each group.**

1. **Number of visits planned : 10 for each group**
2. **2 visits/day of 3 hours each (including travel time)**
3. **3hours X 10 visits =30 hours**
4. **Selection of the visits is based on different settings**

**Children, Disability (Divyang), Hospital, Elderly, Community,  
Women, Correctional, Industry**



- Weekly conferences to clarify the doubts of the students and guidance for correctness
- 3 conferences x 2 hours each = 6 hours
- Reports of each visit is checked by accompanying faculty

## Bridge Course No-3

1. Based on the visits a Seminar is planned of all students
2. A theme is decided and papers are again divided based on settings which are also guided by the faculty members
3. 9.00am to 4.00pm =6 hours

### Overall Credits for Bridge Course:

1.  $1.6 \times 6 = 36$  hours ---2 credits
2.  $2.10 \times 6 = 60$  hours –4 credits
3.  $3.3 \times 2 = 6$  hours
4.  $4.1 \times 6 = 6$  hours =12 hours ( Certificate)
