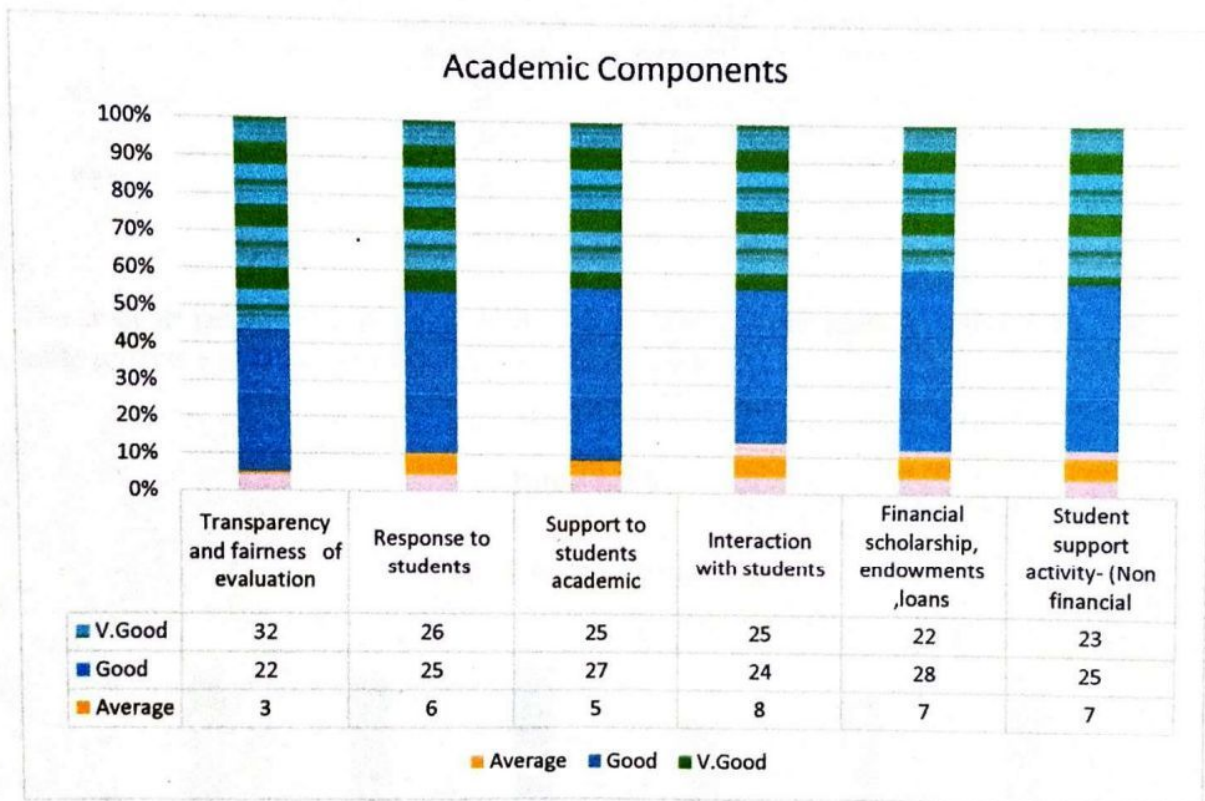


## Students Feedback 2023-24

The detailed students feedback is taken by the institute every year and the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semester. The feedback of 2024 passing out batch is given herewith in total 57 students have responded to the generic/common feedback. Some feedback responses will be lesser as per the specialization intake.

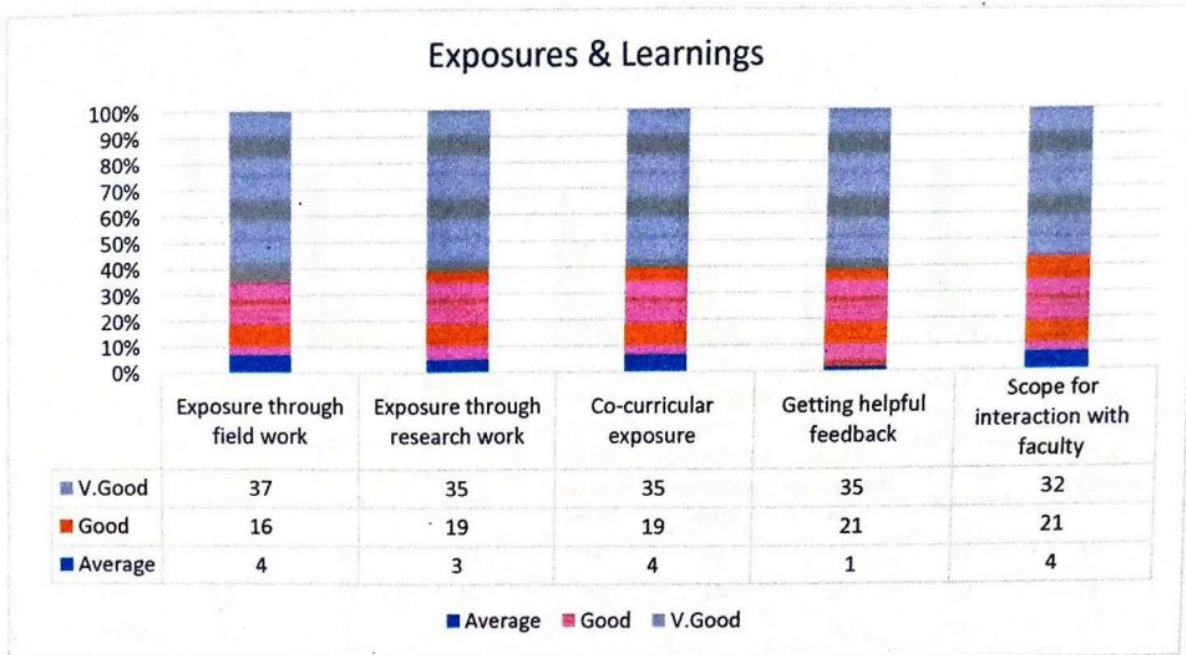
Table no. 1

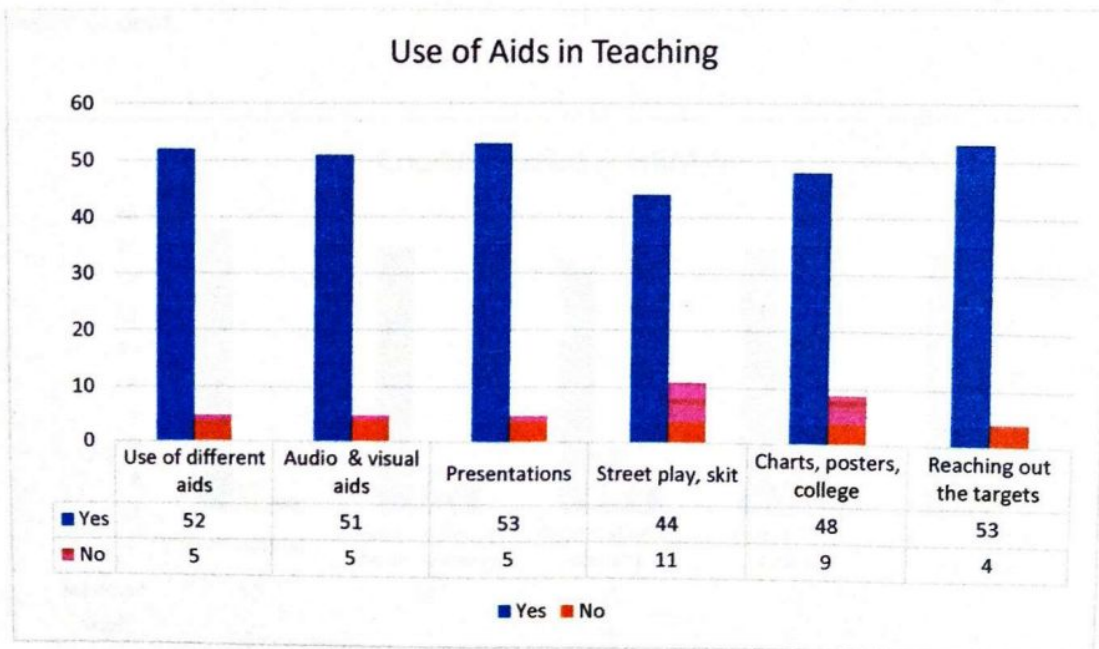

The students get varied exposures about academic components apart from theory and the table reflects a satisfaction of students to a large extent.

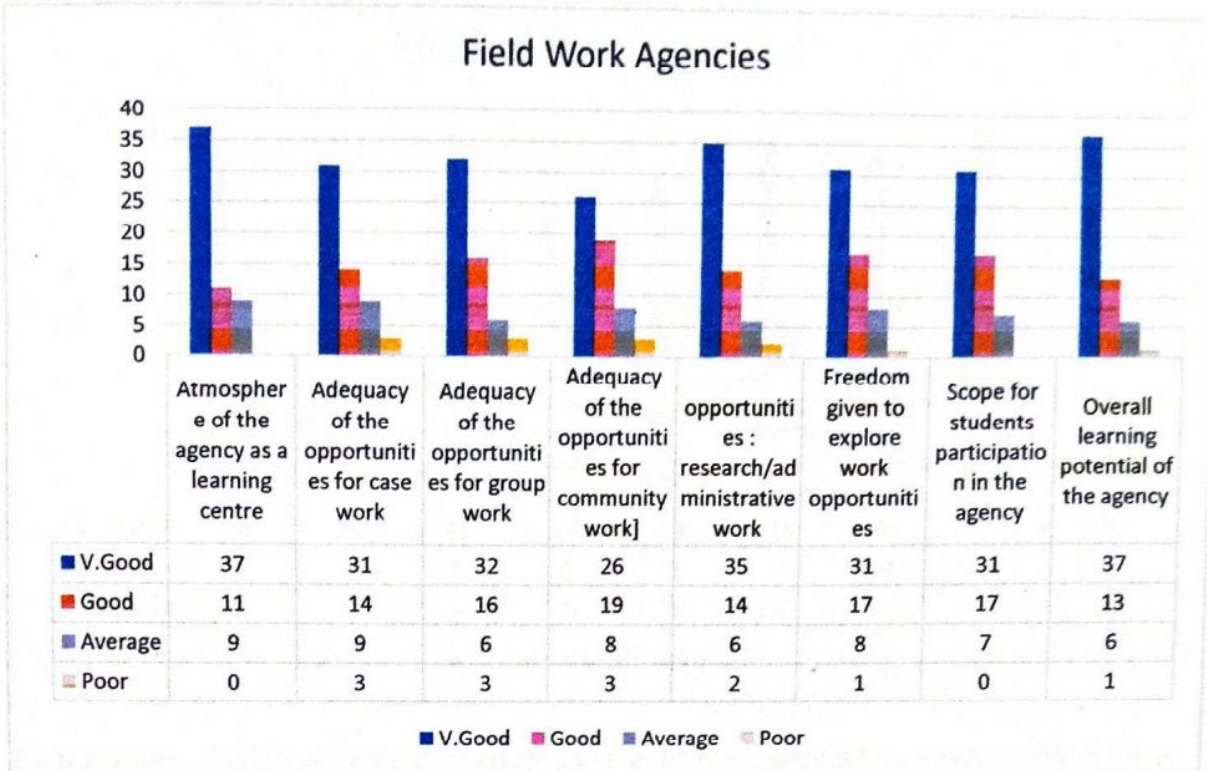

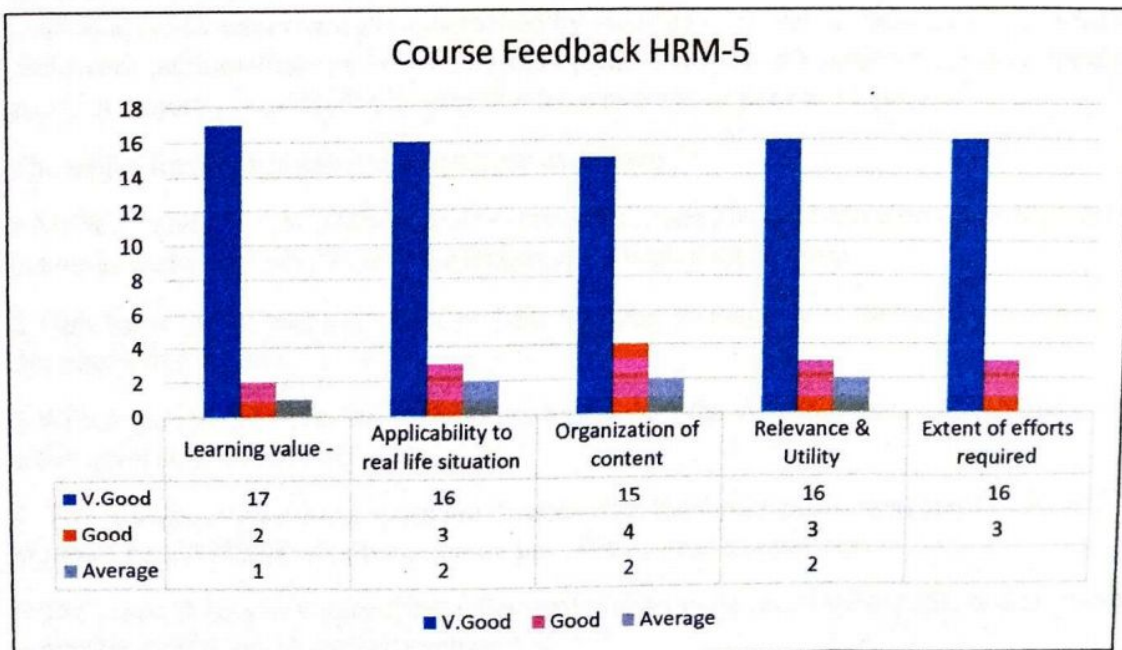
The above table and graph indicates that the use of different aids in classes by different faculty members is done and so majority students are satisfied with the same.

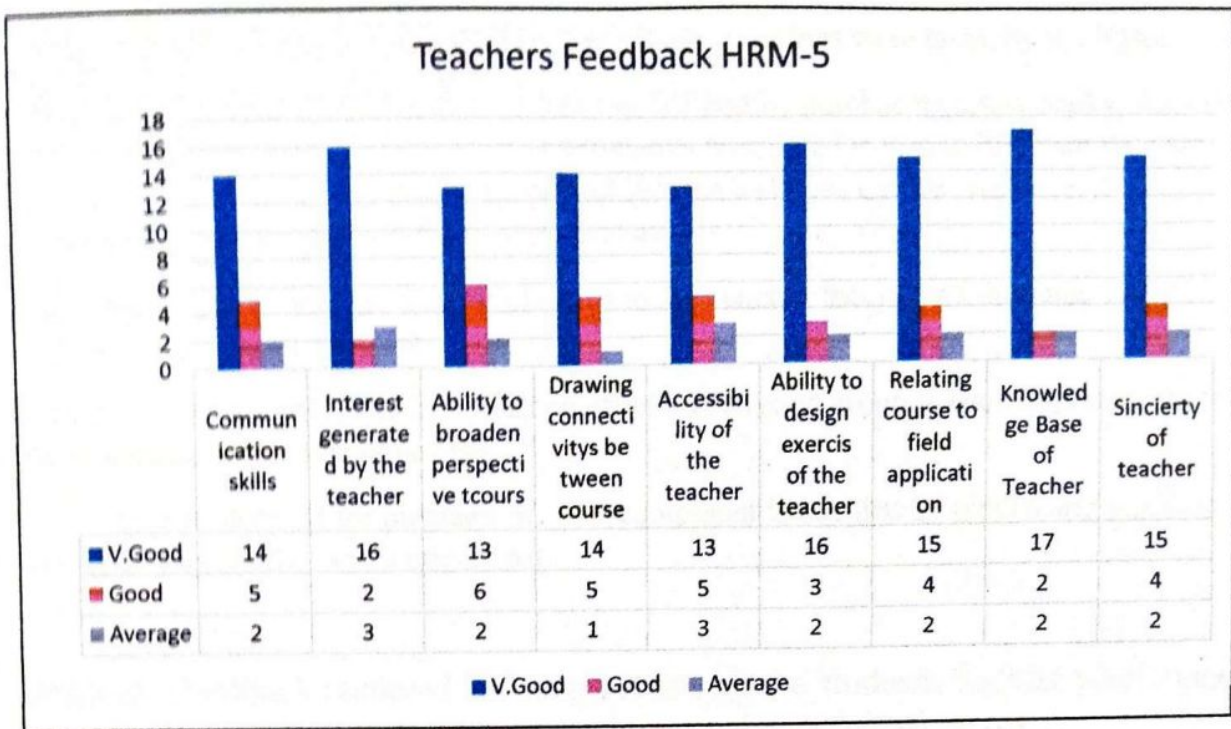


The table indicates that large majority of the students felt that the atmosphere at field work agencies is and all other components are in between very good to good range, which also reflects the teachers efforts in selection of the field work agencies to give best exposure to every student.



The course feedback is taken on five parameters and the data indicates that the majority of students are very happy with the course content





**Conclusions:** Teacher's feedback is taken on nine different parameters and the table reflects that majority of the students are happy with the teacher's teaching methodology.

The institute has its own feedback form created which covers all the different aspects of the syllabus with specific parameters for each. Course content and teachers feedback has five and nine parameters respectively, along with this the students feedback on orientation visits, rural camp, advance orientation visits, study tour field based assignments, fieldwork and administrative aspects. The overall feedback of 55 students of 2<sup>nd</sup> year and 57 students of 1<sup>st</sup> year on all parameters indicate satisfaction by majority of students about teaching of faculty, fieldwork, administrative components and others. The feedback ranges from very good to good on majority indicators and very few have average or poor as responses.

The major feedback given by students are as follows:

1. MSW 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year students have expressed the need to have more books in Marathi as it becomes easier for them to refer for exams and assignment purpose
2. They have appreciated the use of PPT for teaching by majority of the faculty members, and the interactive classes.
3. With regard to the visits the students are happy with the visits but have told that three visits a day become too hectic for them.
4. The academic and other notices are displayed on the notice board regularly however students would like to have the same on the official what's app group.
5. The students have demanded the volley ball ground to be levelled properly, and also some new equipment's for sports be purchased.
