Objective

To provide MSW students with advanced practical exposure to agency functioning, specialization-based placements, and professional engagement, while enabling them to apply classroom learning to real-life field situations.

Description

The MSW II – Semester IV students of Karve Institute of Social Service were placed for **concurrent field** work three days a week during the semester (21st February 2024 to 30th April 2024).

Students were placed in organizations based on their specializations:

- URCD (Urban & Rural Community Development): Placed in NGOs and community-based organizations working in rural, tribal, and urban community development.
- 2. **HRM (Human Resource Management):** Placed in industries, HR departments, and corporate organizations to understand HR policies, labour laws, and employee welfare programmes.
- 3. MPSW (Medical & Psychiatric Social Work): Placed in hospitals, mental health institutions, and health-based organizations to gain practical exposure in patient care, counseling, and rehabilitation services.
- 4. FCW (Family & Child Welfare): Placed in child welfare institutions, family counseling centres, and NGOs working with women and children.

Activities Undertaken

Across all specializations, students completed the following core activities:

- Understanding the Agency: Studied agency structure, objectives, services, and prepared agency profiles.
- Case Work: Conducted client interviews, home visits, and prepared case records.

- Community Work: Interacted with community members, conducted observations, and developed community profiles.


- Agency Assignments: Assisted in programmes such as awareness sessions, surveys, and outreach
